Adoption Protocol:

All applicants wishing to adopt with existing pets must be registered with a vet. References from that vet will be required. Applicants applying for a first pet will need to register with a vet prior to the animal leaving the NARA foster home.

Vetting.

All vetting is ideally to be with adoptive family's existing vet.

Dogs:

- Prior to the adoption starting a home check and vet references are mandatory.
- NARA to be responsible for health check, with the adoptive families own vet where possible, and first vaccinations.
- At this stage the adoptive family should receive a copy of the NARA Adoption Contract.
- Adoptees to be responsible for boosters and spay / neuter as required.
- Appointments to be arranged by or sent to the new adoption coordinator.
- On completion of spay/neuter 50% of the adoption fee (the spay/neuter deposit) will be returned and the contract signed.

Adoption coordinators: Dogs – Michelle & Amy with Cyndi as back up.

Canine adoption fee:

Puppies: \$150 for all sizes and ages with an additional \$150 as a spay/neuter deposit - returnable on completion of spay/neuter and signing of contract.

Adults: \$150 for already fixed dogs (fixed on intake). \$200 for adults fixed whilst in the care of NARA.

Cats:

- Prior to the adoption starting a home check and vet references are mandatory.
- NARA to be responsible for first core vaccinations (RCCP).
- NARA will be responsible for a vet check / report if there have been health issues or concerns.
- Vaccination cards and proof of ownership/adoption should be given to the adoptive family
- Adoptees to be responsible for boosters and spay neuter as required.
- Appointments to be arranged by or sent to the new adoption coordinator.
- On completion of spay/neuter 50% of the adoption fee will be returned and the contract signed.

Adoption coordinators are: Laurie & Rosie with Michelle, Cindy & Pip as backup.

Feline adoption fees:

\$200 for unfixed kittens (under 6 months of age)

\$125 for adults fixed whilst in the care of NARA

\$100 for already fixed cats (fixed on intake)

Barn cats (feral) and seniors (>7 years) are by donation
